The local region benefits from a unique climate and chalky soil, ideal for producing high-quality sparkling wines and distinctive ales.













Stunning walks through the Shimmings Valley offers the perfect opportunity to enjoy Petworth's natural beauty.










History

Experience

Petworth's strong community spirit shines through its year-round events.

The monthly Farmers' Market connects visitors with the best regional produce and celebrates local talent and craftsmanship. The Fête in the Park brings summer festivities, while the Hampers Green Bonfire Night lights up the autumn skies. As winter approaches, the town sparkles with seasonal cheer during the Christmas Cracker event, a full day of stalls, music and festive celebration.

At the heart of Petworth stands Petworth House and Park, a National Trust treasure and home to one of Britain's finest art collections, featuring masterpieces by Turner, Van Dyck, and Blake. Wander its 700-acre Capability Brown-designed parkland, where deer roam freely, and history comes to life.











Explore

With so much nearby, Petworth is the perfect base for exploring West Sussex.

Just beyond Petworth, the historic Coultershaw Beam Pump is a fascinating stop before exploring the many attractions within a 12-mile radius.

Explore Arundel Castle, Parham House, and Bignor Roman Villa, or enjoy world-class events at Cowdray Polo and Glorious Goodwood.

History and culture await at Chichester Cathedral and Amberley Museum, while nature lovers can spot rare wildlife at RSPB Pulborough Brooks.













Easily accessible yet perfectly secluded, Petworth is closer than you think:



Well connected via the A272 and A283, just over an hour's drive from London, and within easy reach of Chichester, Brighton, and Guildford.



Nearby stations at Pulborough (5 miles) and Haslemere (12 miles) offer regular services to London and the South Coast.



Direct services link Petworth to Pulborough Station, Midhurst, Chichester, and Worthing, making travel simple and convenient.

Parking available in the town centre (250 spaces and electric chargers) and at The Sylvia Beaufoy Centre (72 spaces).


